Of course there were some other reasons that caused it, but the main reason definitely came from my family. 



ortality rates and domestic violence are two major risks in child marriage. Generally speaking, girls' physical conditions are not fully developed and will not mature until puberty. Therefore, the law seriously forbids anyone to have sex with underage girls, and allow for single girls to get pregnant. Nevertheless, there are still many parents who neglect the law and force underage girls to marry. This situation brings out some unlucky people who cannot survive labor and the babies will not have any chance to see the world. Even though some people are fortunate to escape death, it does not mean that they will not be confronted with domestic violence. Owing to lower status and powerlessness in the family, they often become their husbands' punching bags; moreover, they do not have appropriate ways to search for help and have to live under the threatening circumstances. Therefore, decreasing child marriage is an inevitable action to protect more young lives from tragedy.

o sum up, child marriage is composed of many factors like poverty, lack of education and some of the previously mentioned dangers. None of them will disappear, but once we care about this issue, then I believe that this problem will be solved.


